UPDATE: Neighborhood Expansion!!

The newest Woodlands Edge neighborhood, Tallgrass, is scheduled to open within the next few weeks. This neighborhood will contain larger executive home sites, all with great views and greenspace. New homes will range from around 3000 square feet to well over 5000 square feet.

In addition, another phase of Foxfield is in the works. This phase will contain 42 new lots with homes ranging from around 2500 square feet to over 3500 square feet. This new phase is scheduled to open in the summer of 2008.



The long awaited connection to Kanis Road should start soon! This will be a very attractive roadway and will contain two additional traffic circles. It will connect from the 3rd circle north to Kanis Road in the vicinity of the Cooper Orbit Road intersection with Kanis. Completion is expected later this year.

Wildlife Habitat Restoration

The Nature Conservancy, in conjunction with Audubon Arkansas, will be conducting a control burn of a 2 acre grassy meadow adjacent to the new Tallgrass neighborhood in Woodlands Edge. This is being done in order to restore and promote growth of native wildflowers. The actual burn will not take much more than one hour to complete. The use of fire as a management tool to restore wildlife habitat within an urbanized area is probably a first in Arkansas and is in keeping with our commitment to conservation in Woodlands Edge.

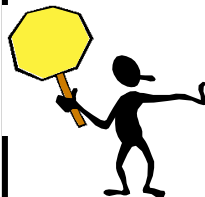

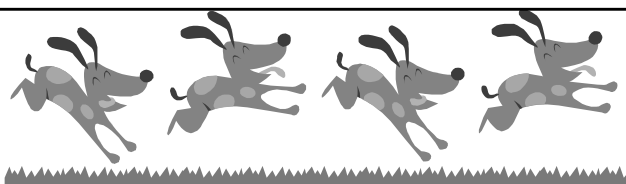
The ACC reminds you that :

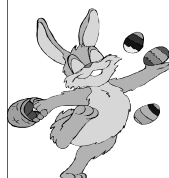
